

Grissettown Longwood Fire & Rescue

Job Description Definitions

The Grissettown - Longwood Fire & Rescue is a combination fire department and is staffed by volunteer and paid members. These members have a variety of duties and job descriptions.

Chief- A firefighter which has the highest level of authority at a fire scene and is responsible for the general operations of the fire service.

1st Assistant Chief- A firefighter which has the second highest level of authority at a fire scene and is responsible for assisting the chief in general operations of the fire service. This member is in charge in the chief's absence.

2nd Assistant Chief- A firefighter which has the third highest level of authority at a fire scene and is responsible for assisting the chief in the absence of the 1st assistant. This member is in charge in the absence of the chief and 1st asst.

Captain- A firefighter which assists the chiefs at the fire scene and is responsible for assisting the chief in the general operations of the fire service.

Lieutenant- A firefighter which assists the chiefs at the fire scene and is responsible for assisting the chief in the general operations of the fire service.

Safety Officer – The officer who is responsible for the overall safety of members at any fire department location where member safety is of concern.

Training Officer- The officer that is responsible for organizing training for the other members of Grissettown Longwood Fire & Rescue.

Firefighter- Any person qualified by the Grissettown Longwood Fire & Rescue to respond to an emergency.
