Driver Operator

- The Driver Operator shall be 21 years of age, unless authorized by the chief, and hold a valid North Carolina driver's license with a good driving record and an EVD certificate.
- The Driver Operator must hold insurance coverage on their private vehicle.
- The Driver Operator shall have a working knowledge of the vehicle that they are assigned to remove from the station.
- The Driver Operator should have knowledge of the water supply, friction loss, Fire Apparatus Placement, and equipment on the apparatus, hydraulics and pumps, as needed, for the vehicle which they operate.
- The Driver Operator shall operate the vehicle at the scene until the incident is secured or is properly relieved by the incident commander
- The Driver Operator should have knowledge of geographic area protected by the department.
- The Driver Operator shall verify that the apparatus is serviced as needed after every use.
- The Driver Operator shall obey the traffic laws of the state of North Carolina when operating apparatus in both emergency and non-emergency response situations.
- The Driver Operator should not move any fire apparatus that is involved in an accident; They shall contact the proper authorities and shall assist the chief or commanding officer in filling out an accident report.
