

Grissettown Longwood Vehicle Extrication Competition 2018

Objective:

To safely perform a scene size up, vehicle stabilization, extrication and extinguish a fire on a vehicle accident scenario. The windshield and roof will already be split into two allow each team to function independent from each other.

1. Scene Size Up
2. Tool Hook Up
3. Vehicle Stabilization
4. Remove Windshield
5. Remove Top
6. Perform a Relief Cut
7. Perform a Dash Roll
8. Extinguish a Fire

Equipment:

- A. Extrication Tools (TNT Combi (spreader/cutter) Ram and O Cutter)
- B. 2 Battery Operated Reciprocating Saw
- C. Cribbing Material (step crib and 4x4)
- D. Flat head Ax
- E. Halligan Bar
- F. Fire Extinguisher (Water Can)

Event:

Each team will consist of three (3) personnel throughout the scenario. The team leaders will draw their starting position (driver or passenger side) on the vehicle. Each team will be given the scenario and safety briefing by the event judge, if a team has any questions about the scenario they will be addressed at this time. After all questions have been answered, the event judge will announce that the event will start on the sound of a whistle, horn, siren or starting gun. Each team will be required to hook up their tools up, perform a scene size up, locate and identify hazards, remove the windshield, remove two doors, make a cut on A, B, C post to remove the top, perform a relief cut and perform a dash roll. The scenario ends when the first team has completed their task and extinguished a fire with a fire extinguisher.

Rules:

1. Professionalism will be shown at all times. This means no profanity, arguing with

the judges, other teams or each other, unruly conduct, etc.

2. SAFETY is of an utmost importance. In all events you will conduct yourself in a safe manner.

3. Team members must be a member of a fire, rescue or ems department to be covered by their department's insurance.

Each team will be made of maximum of three (3) personnel.

4. This is a **friendly** competition, so a member of any team may stand in for or participate on another team. Teams maybe mixed matched from different departments or department sponsored.

5. Turnout or extrication gear will be worn on this event. This includes helmet, boots, coat, pants, gloves and safety glasses. (Coat and pants may be the traditional turnout gear or may be an approved extrication suit (2 piece or jump suits). Boots may be bunker boots or steel toe leather boots.

6. All teams will use the same tools and equipment.

7. All tools and equipment will be provided by Grissettown Longwood Fire & Rescue.

8. Time will begin when event judge signals for the event to begin.

9. Time will end when the first time extinguishes a fire from the fire prop.

10. Judges will consist of one event judge and one safety judge

11. In the event of a tie the winner will be decided by the speculators.

12. The event judge will announce the winner.
