## **Key Safety Behaviors**

- Drive Defensively
- Drive slower rather than faster
- Intersection: if you can't see, stop
- Always wear your seat belt
- Wear full gear
- Don't ever breath smoke
- Attack with a sensible level of aggression
- Always work under command - NO FREELANCING
- Keep your crew intact
- Maintain a communication link with your command
- Always have an escape route (hose line / life line)
- Never go beyond the safety limits of your air supply
- Use a big enough and long enough line
- Evaluate the hazard—know the risk you are taking
- Follow standard fire ground procedures at all times
- Know and be a part of the plan
- Vent early and vent often

- Provide lights for the work area
- If it's heavy, get help
- Always watch your fire ground position
- Look and listen for signs of collapse
- Rehab fatigued firefighters
- Pay attention at all times
- Everyone takes care of everyone else
- Always use all personal protective equipment
